*A Note From Bryan. . . We are one day closer to redemption*

In Luke 21 Jesus began to tell His disciples about a terrible series of events that were going to occur in their lifetime. We now know that Jesus began and ended this conversation with details that pointed to the destruction of Jerusalem around 70 AD. Embedded in this conversation (vv. 25-28) Jesus talked about a similar event that would occur much later. Verses 25-28 seems to be pointing to Jesus' final return.

When you think about it, we are now one day closer to those events actually occurring. Here we wait for the return of Jesus Christ to take us to heaven to be with Him for eternity. We are one day closer to final redemption.

One thing about Jesus' words in these few verses is that they sound so eerily familiar: distress of nations, waves roaring, men's hearts failing from fear. Right now the entire globe is financially distressed. All you need to do is read the *Wall Street Journal* or *Newsweek* and it's plastered all over every page. Also in the media are the recent terrible earthquakes with their subsequent destruction and death. The quake in Chile has sent out Tsunami warnings throughout the Pacific Rim.

Verse 28 teaches us something vitally important. Jesus said that when we see these things, "Look up." Jesus said that we need to "look up" because our redemption is near. In other Scriptures it says these are the last days we're in (Hebrews 1:2). We have so many reasons to be looking up right now. This morning that is what we are going to discuss, "Look up."
