The (4) W's of Lads to Leaders – by Don Williams

(1) What is Lads to Leaders?

Lads to Leaders & Leaderettes is a program designed to prepare the youngest of our congregation to be better servants of our Lord. The program began over 40 years ago when Jack Zorn took a small group of young men from his home congregation and started training them to be Church leaders. Brother Zorn would often take his youth group to other congregations where they would lead the worship service. Eventually the young girls of the congregation got involved. They were and still are today taught some of the same skills although they are designed to be used in a ladies only setting. The program has been such a success that in only 40 years it grew from less than 10 participants to over 18,000.

(2) Why do we participate in the Lads to Leaders program here at Woodstock?

We use the Lads to Leaders program as a tool to help our young boys and girls develop the leadership skills that they need to be effective leaders and workers for the Lord. I've participated in Lads to Leaders since I was a kid. So I've been involved with the program for close to 30 years now. I've gone to a lot of conventions. Around 30 years ago I was one of those kids that was motivated by the competition aspect of the program. However, I've never won a Lads to Leaders trophy. Not one made of wood, plastic, or a piece of marble anyway, but I have been very rewarded by the program. I remember delivering a 5 minute sermon on the necessity of baptism at my home congregation when I was around 15 years old. Later that day one of my little sisters was baptized. Now that's a trophy! I'm sure that she had been thinking about being baptized for a while but I like to think that my sermon helped. If it wasn't for Lads to Leaders I wouldn't have known how to or been given the opportunity to deliver that speech.

(3) Who is involved in the Lads to Leaders program at Woodstock?

The program is designed for school age children but it takes an entire congregation to really make the program work. This year we had around 100 attend the convention.

(4) Where is the Woodstock Lads to Leaders program going?

Well that's up to us as a congregation. We have a great group of young people here at Woodstock and I believe that the Lord is using this program to bless them - as well as the adults who are serving as Leaders in the program. This year has been very uplifting to me. I'm encouraged and excited about the potential of our youth group and look forward to seeing them glorify God. The program has been a huge blessing to me personally. There is nothing like watching your kids serve our Lord. As a parent it really doesn't get any better than that!
