A Note From Bryan. . . The Only Name

Names can invoke powerful responses. What is your natural reaction when you hear the name Manson or McVey? Compare that with how you react to the Thomas Jefferson or Abraham Lincoln. In Acts 4:12 Peter responded to threats from the Jewish counsel stating, "Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved." The Sanhedrin used intimidation to try to get Peter and John to stop spreading the message of Jesus Christ. For some, the name of Christ brought a sense of hope and peace, to others Jesus' name brought on feelings of anger and hostility.

The name of Jesus still produces strong reactions in people. Jesus is the only name that has the power behind it to make people angry. Have you ever heard anyone take Buddha's name in vain or text "OMB"? Jerry Shirley, a Baptist minister from Decatur, Illinois, rightly asks the question, "Have you ever heard anyone ask, 'What in Allah's name is going on here?'" Truth hurts in a way nothing else can. The names of dead religious leaders are not nearly as potent as a RISEN LORD!

Jesus' name is the only one powerful enough to make the alcoholic put away the beverage, make liars tell the truth, turn abusive men into saints, purify prostitutes, and save souls from eternal torture. Given these truths why is it that we as Christians wink at taking the Lord's name in vain? Is it such an innocent thing that our young people are given to texting "OMG" or vainly parroting the word in reaction to teenage drama? As we will see in this morning's lesson God's name; His son's name is so powerful we ought not speak it in vain.
