A Note From Bryan... Graduation & Commencement

Graduation and Commencement are two words synonymous with a new phase of life. We say congratulations to all of our graduates as they begin this new phase of their lives. You are closing one chapter of your life and opening a larger, more exciting chapter. You may be planning to have a lot of fun this summer and I hope that works out for you but let me bring you back down to earth for a few minutes. I promise it won't spoil your fun.

People are going to look at you differently. I don't mean that they will look at you like you've got chocolate all over your mouth or something stuck in your teeth. This also does not mean that people are going to look at you as a full-fledged adult. People are going to be expecting more of you. Your boss, your parents, and other people close to you are going to be expecting you to be responsible. They are going to expect you to be able to do more. People are going to expect you to be more independent in ways you haven't yet thought of like being able to do a job adequately without supervision. Some of you may already be there; for others of you it's going to be something new. I will pass on this piece of advice that was given to me by an early employer: "learn to take the initiative." Don't wait to be told to do something. If you see something that needs to be done, take the initiative and do it.

Things have changed more than you realize. There are going to be friends you will lose contact with but you are surely going to make some new ones and chances are the friends you make over the next few years are going to be lifelong friends; choose well. The things you thought were important won't be important anymore. In the next two to five years "cool" won't mean anything other than a description of something you like. "Popular" isn't going to mean anything either, it will become "politics."

There are some things you need to remember as you enter this next exciting phase of your life that we are going to talk about. The text for this morning's lesson is just one verse, 1 Corinthians 13:13 "And now abide faith, hope, love, these three; but the greatest of these is love." As you go forward from today you will need to be reminded to be faithful, to be hopeful, and to be loving and lovable.
