### A Note From Bryan... Reception versus Rejection

Reception versus rejection is the comparison between those who received Jesus and those who rejected Jesus in His early ministry. In all my previous studies I had overlooked this stark contrast. In Luke 4 Jesus began His ministry in His home town of Nazareth. He attended the Synagogue on the Sabbath and was asked to read. By the time Jesus finished applying what He had read from the Isaiah scroll to His time and that particular audience the men of the Synagogue wanted to throw Jesus off a cliff.

Jesus proceeded to Capernaum, a town in the region of Galilee, where He again taught in the Synagogue. This time a man with an unclean, demonic spirit stood up and caused a troubling scene. These demons knew Jesus was the Son of God and blurted it out to the dismayed crowd. Of course Jesus cast out the unclean spirit, saving the man. The people in Capernaum opened their arms to Jesus, amazed at His words and His authority over unclean spirits. They began to tell everyone they could tell about Jesus.

This success in Capernaum set off a chain reaction of people coming to Him and bringing others to hear and to be healed, Luke 5:15. In the 40<sup>th</sup> verse of chapter four it states that those who came to Jesus to be healed were healed by His touch and His words. These two reactions of receiving and rejecting are interesting when you consider the various individuals Jesus encountered in His ministry. Jesus met all kinds and yet all those different people could easily be lumped into one of these two general categories: those who receive and those who reject Jesus.

This morning we will look at the different characteristics of those who receive and those who reject Jesus throughout chapters four through six of Luke's gospel. I want to share with you what I have found in the hopes that it will enrich your personal ministry and help you as you encounter so many different people with so many different personalities and attitudes. This should help you realize that everyone in this world will fit into one of these categories despite their individual uniqueness.
