A Note From Bryan. . . In the Name of the Lord

Do you remember the first time your parents gave you "the talk?" No, I don't mean the talk about the birds and the bees, I mean the talk about your behavior when you were away from home or going away from home for the first time. You know, this was the talk you got about "remembering where you come from..." or the "mind your manners..." conversation. If your parents were like mine they were terribly conscious of how your behavior reflected upon them and they probably took it very personally. As all kids do, I would burst through the back door leaving it open and the first words from my mother's mouth were, "Were you born in a barn? Close that door behind you!" Mom and Dad didn't want my friend's parents thinking that I was born in a barn.

Just like your parents wanted you to present an image of wholesome parentage, our Father in heaven wants the same for His children in this earth. Our New Testaments provide us with the same kind of instructions. Likely, that is where our parents got the idea to begin with. The inspired apostle Paul was one of those with the authority to give God's children "the talk" about our behavior in the world among people who don't know God or His son. Colossians 3 is where we find some of this parental instruction.

In Colossians 3:17 after talking about the image of Christianity Paul wrote, "Whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through Him to God the Father." We do and say many things that according to Colossians 3:10 ought to reflect that pure, wholesome image of our creator. The hope for this morning is to put us in mind of how we use our conversations and our lives as a demonstration of our divine parentage.
