Russia & Ukraine Know What's Good for Them

States in Russia and Ukraine have asked EEM to put Bibles and Biblical literature in all the public schools in those states. The state of Krasnoyarsk, Russia, and Ivano-Frankivsk, Ukraine, total 1,063 schools in which there are over 250,000 students. Why have they asked for the Bible? The number one reason is to "bring up the next generation" based on the Bible. After the moral void left by communism, many of the youth have no moral compass and are engaging in self-destructive behavior. Many teachers and parents want something real and lasting for their children. Many are turning to the Bible. They know what is good for them. They have asked EEM for the Bible for their schools. To respond to their request, EEM will hold The \$1,000,000 Sunday on October 31, 2010. Churches of Christ nationwide are asked to provide gifts to be used to fill all the schools in these two states with God's word.

A Note From Bryan. . . In the Heat of the Moment

What you do in the heat of the moment often stands out as proof of your character. When stress piles up on you to the breaking point and then the boss enters the room shouting more orders at you often defines how far you go in your career. It is not just your ability to be resilient, it is your ability to remain in control of your emotions in a stressful situation. Your style under stress is an important aspect of your personality and even your character.

It has been said that character is what you are when no one is looking. However, your influence depends upon those who are looking. So it might also be said of character that your character is what you are and how you behave when you are pressed all around. How you react to stressful situations is a part of your character and one that can be moved in a positive direction with a little effort.

We all have both good and bad examples in our lives of times when we've personally lost it and later regretted it. We all have both good and bad examples of people handling stressful situations. Our best example of how to behave when physically and emotionally stressed is Jesus Christ.

Jesus knew how to deal with the temptations that come with stressful situations. Jesus knew how to deal with His own anger and disappointment. He didn't just stand by and let merchants take over His father's house. Jesus knew how to handle a threat and He knew how to deal with violence. These are all extreme examples and yet we deal with many of these in different measures and it is helpful for us to keep in mind that Jesus dealt with all these things and gave us a perfect example how to deal with them in the heat of the moment.
